

RULES & CONDITIONS

1. The Organisers accept no responsibility for accidents or injury to any competitors, spectators, animals or equipment. Admission and entries are accepted on this condition.
2. Riders must wear hard hats to PAS015/EN1384 and appropriate clothing must be worn. Body protectors are strongly recommended.
3. **No dogs** allowed on the showground.
4. Objections must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the judges decision along with a £5.00 deposit if the objection is sustained.
5. Galloping and excessive use of the practice area is strictly forbidden.
6. No entry will be refunded unless a valid veterinary or doctor's certificate is produced. An admin fee will be deducted.
7. Competitors are eliminated after 3 refusals at any one fence but may be allowed to continue at the **discretion of the jump judge**. They must give way to other competitors at all times.
8. Competitors at all times must make way for faster horses. Failure to do so will mean elimination.
9. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entries.
10. Riders must walk the course and be happy they can compete at the level they wish to ride before entering.
11. A charge of £2.00 will be made for changes to entries on the day.
12. Unfortunately, we cannot accept entries from stallions.

COMMENCING AT 9.00 A.M.

- Class 1 **MINIMUS** - Shortened Course - 2ft max.
Aimed at nervous and young riders. The idea of this course is to give confidence. If you are capable of doing better please do not enter. Entries will not be accepted for the same combination of horse and rider wishing to enter both classes 1 and 2.
- Class 2 **NOVICE – Qualifier***
Fences approx 2'3" - 2'6"
Open to combination of any horse and rider
- Class 3 **PAIRS – Qualifier ***
Fences as class 2
Open to combination of any horse and rider
- Class 4 **OPEN – Qualifier***
Fences 3'0" maximum
Open to combination of any horse and rider

Entry Fees: Classes 1, 2, 4 £14.00 per person
Class 3 £20.00 per pair

Course may be walked from 2.00 p.m. on Saturday before show.

This competition has a time section. Competitors are not issued with times. You will need to put your number at the start box on arrival.

*This event is a qualifier for the Final of South Essex Insurance Brokers BHS Cross Country Championships 2009. In the nominated qualifying classes, the TWO highest placed riders (or two highest placed Pairs) who are BHS gold members ON THE DAY OF THE QUALIFIER will qualify for the Final. In the event of a combination of horse/pony and rider already having qualified, the qualification, the qualification will pass down to the next eligible competitor. You must provide the Entries Secretary with your BHS membership card on the day. Non-members may enter qualifying classes but will not be eligible to qualify. Horses registered for British Eventing Horse Trials in 2010 are NOT eligible to qualify for the Finals (BE day tickets are acceptable). Rules at qualifiers may differ from those at the Finals. Classes at the Finals will be Novice and Pairs (both max 2'9"), and Open (max 3'3").
