CODE OF CONDUCT

1. All clients must wear B.S.I. hats numbers: PAS015 or BSEN1384 whenever participating in riding activities.
2. Horse riding is a risk sport, participation therefore holds potential danger.
3. All clients must wear an approved back protector for jumping lessons.
4. Horses are sometimes unpredictable and do not always respond as expected.
5. We advise all persons participating in any equestrian activity to ensure they have adequate personal accident insurance.
6. All clients are asked to wear flat-soled shoes/boots with a small heel and gloves. Trainers are not acceptable.
7. Clients are asked not to wear jewellery of any description whilst around the riding centre.
8. No new clients are to hack around farm without assessment or being led.
9. All children riding must be 4 years and over.
10. If a parent allows a child to be left on the premises out of their lesson time, it is purely at their own risk and not the responsibility of the proprietor or staff.
11. All children **must** be signed in at the office. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to ensure children are instructed not to leave the premises.
12. Clients are requested to inform Pinkmead Farm Riding Centre if any of the information given on the client registration form is altered.
13. All instructors are trained and competent to teach to their detailed level. All clients retain the right to request a change of instructor.
14. Please see cancellation policy relating to lesson cancellations.
15. If insufficient number of riders in lesson or activity we reserve the right to cancel or reduce lesson time.
16. We retain the right to terminate a client contract.
17. All children on Pinkmead Farm premises (including those here for a lesson) **MUST AT ALL TIMES** be under the **DIRECT** supervision of an adult. The only exception to this is in respect of children who are loaning ponies or are here for an activity where the parent or guardian has entered them in the daily register and indicated when they will be collected. In no other circumstances must a child be dropped off and collected later. Under no circumstances must children not here for a lesson be allowed to leave the direct supervision of the accompanying adult.
18. The livery yard areas are strictly out of bounds.
19. Please do not feed horses or ponies.

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
