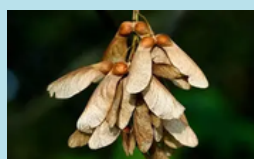

Riding different horses.....

Every horse has their own personality and ability, and be able to ride a range of horses is a key part of being a good horse rider. But you're not alone if the thought of riding an unfamiliar horse is daunting – that's totally normal!

Riding lots of different horses will help you become a better rider because you'll learn new skills, overcome challenges and feel more confident as a result. Getting used to horses different ways of going will make you a more adaptable rider, which means you'll be able to get the most out of every horse you ride.

Remember your instructor would never put you on a horse you are not ready to ride! If your instructor has put you on that horse then you are definitely ready.

Don't judge a horse on what you have seen or heard. Don't let other peoples opinions cloud your judgement and ride them based how they are on that day.
