- The organizing committee does not accept liability for damage, any accident or injury of any kind to any person, animal or property whatsoever.
- The judges decision is final.
- The Committee reserve the right to refuse entry without reason, alter the date, the schedule and allocation of prizes.
- No lungeing
- Any competitor who, in the eyes of the judge or steward ill treats or causes suffering to any horse or pony will be asked to leave the showground.
- No horse or pony may be entered in the same class more than once.
- It is regretted that no entry can be refunded and any withdrawal must be accompanied by a doctor's or veterinary surgeon's certificate and a stamped addressed envelope sent to the entries' secretary
- Objections must be made in writing and given to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident, with a deposit of £10.00 which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- Correct riding dress must be worn at all times including hard hat to current British standard
- **No dogs allowed on the Centre's premises.**
- Judging will be under British Dressage Rules.

Qualification: 1st – 4th place. Qualification does not pass down the line.
